





In the dahlia show's of the post war years the top giant grower was a Mr G.F.Drayson he won the Windolite cup which called for nine varieties three blooms of each in a vase, twenty seven blooms in total. His success in 1948 gave him the trophy outright winning it three In 1949 there was a new trophy times. for the giants called the A.T.Barnes, for twelve varieties one bloom per vase. This was to give more scope to many growers of large decorative Dahlias who were unable to exhibit the large number of blooms previously required. It did increase the number of exhibitors in the class but was again won by George. He went onto win it for the next three years with help of the new verities like H.M.Queen Elizabeth, Lily Vandyk, Five Star General, Mrs Hester Pape, Black Monarch, Freda George, Charles Mastick, Sherwood, s Peach, Essie Smith and Dawson.
